### The Inspiration of Daniel

<u>Daniel 1:3</u> And the king spake unto <u>Ashpenaz</u> the <u>master of his eunuchs</u>, that he should bring certain of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes;

**Hebrew** – *Ashpenaz* = "I will make prominent the sprinkled"

#### The Inspiration of Daniel

#### The King desired:

- 1) No Blemish
- 2) Well-Favoured
- 3) Skillful in Wisdom
- 4) Cunning in knowledge
- 5) Understanding Science
- 6) Ability in them to STAND in king's palace

**Daniel 1:4** Children in whom was no blemish, but well favoured, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as had ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans.

- Hebrews 12:22 But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,
- 23 To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to <u>God</u> the Judge of all, and to the spirits of <u>just men made</u> perfect,

- Hebrews 12:3 For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.
- 4 Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin.

  example of suffering affliction, and of patience.
- 11 Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy.

### The Inspiration of Daniel

<u>Daniel 1:5</u> And the king appointed them a <u>daily</u> <u>provision of the king's meat</u>, and of the wine which he drank: so nourishing them three years, that at the end thereof <u>they might stand</u> before the king.

Dan 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.

- The saints of God are not of the world. We are a royal Priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people.
- While we can learn from our careers and education, we must not allow our hearts to be filled with the world.
- The kings' meat represents "the things that are in the world". Notice the liberal schools are educating with a Godless base and attempting to destroy purity.

### The Inspiration of Daniel

 By refusing the King's meat, the children were fairer and FATTER than all of the other children.

 <u>Dan 1:17</u> As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams.

#### The Inspiration of Daniel

• <u>Dan 1:20</u> And in all matters of wisdom and understanding, that the king enquired of them, <u>he found them ten times better</u> than all the magicians and astrologers that were in all his realm.

Our fasting and consecration to God fulfills the purpose of separation from the world but ALSO prepares our souls to be used in Spiritual Gifts and when our minds and hearts are open to God, we can focus and EXCEL at a level that is only possible when walking in the Holy Ghost.

- Husband: Honey, that is a such a weird way to start a conversation?

Listening

 Proverbs 20:5 Counsel in the heart of man is like deep water; But a man of understanding will draw it out.6 Most men will proclaim every one his own goodness: But a faithful man who can find?

#### Listening

Listening is what matures us both in listening to authority (God) and to our subordinates (those who we serve)

James 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is <u>first</u> <u>pure</u>, then <u>peaceable</u>, <u>gentle</u>, and <u>easy to be</u> <u>intreated</u>, <u>full of mercy and good fruits</u>, <u>without</u> <u>partiality</u>, and <u>without hypocrisy</u>.

 James 1:19 Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath: 20 for the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God.

 Listening along with patient response will produce the best counsel

- Feel after the Holy Ghost in your Bible Study / SS Classes
- When teaching student(s) we should consider a time for us to hear them. (Especially new convert) give them time to respond to us. Encourage questions and don't be swift to an answer, feel their infirmities and "wear their shoes".
- We will be much more effective if we listen

- Sometimes a Bible Study may turn into a listening session. If you discussed a verse and had prayer, don't see letting them talk as a waste of time.
- We have seen that if a soul is struggling and we let them speak their heart, we will earn their trust. This will open the ground of their heart to receive seed.

- Listen to your spouse! When taking time with each other focus on listening!
- In the family room, at dinner, on vacations LISTEN to our children!!!!! It is critical to know what is going on in our children's hearts, take time and work on being close enough to where you listen to them, let them feel they can bear their heart to us and that it is important to us!

#### Not listening is foolish and selfish

• <u>Proverbs 18:2</u> A fool hath no delight in understanding, but that his heart may discover itself.

#### AMPLIFIED:

• Proverbs 18:2 A [closed-minded] fool does not delight in understanding, But only in revealing his personal opinions [unwittingly displaying his self-indulgence and his stupidity].

#### It is dangerous to give an answer before hearing

• <u>Proverbs 18:3</u> When the wicked cometh, then cometh also contempt, and with ignominy reproach.

#### AMPLIFIED:

• Proverbs 18:3 When the wicked man comes [to the depth of evil], contempt [of all that is pure and good] also comes, And with inner baseness (dishonor) comes outer shame (scorn).

- Listening as taught by Jesus:
- John 7:24 Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.
- Matthew 23:24 Ye blind guides, which strain at a gnat, and swallow a camel.
- <u>Luke 4:4</u> And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, <u>but</u> by every word of God.

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
